



Klippekort

From January 01. 2018 a new "klippe kort" system is being introduced. This system means that the amount of time available for each module of your Danish education will be regulated in a new way.

Klippekort

If you are working, studying or if you are an Au Pair in Denmark, then you are entitled to free Danish classes within the conditions of this new "klippe kort" system. The "klippe kort" system is a system of units regulating the amount of time available to you to complete each module and your Danish education. The number of units that you are entitled to depends on which module you are placed when you start your Danish education. You are given a maximum of 6 units, corresponding to 42 months or 3 ½ years of Danish classes. One unit allows you to attend one module for a certain number of months. If you do not pass the module test within the time limit, then the next unit will be activated.

If you have any questions about the "klippe kort" system, please ask at the reception desk.

The "klippe kort" is valid for 5 years from the date on which you are first referred to Danish classes. The "klippe kort" is however first activated when you have been offered a class. **The unit will be activated whether you attend classes or not. In other words, you will be using your units even if you do not attend classes.**

When a unit expires, the next unit is immediately activated.

You are entitled to take a break after passing a module test. If you would like to do this then you must inform the language centre in writing as quickly as possible and before the next module starts. In addition you must inform the language centre when you would like to start again.



Extension of the "Klippekort" and Danish education period

If you have been unable to participate in Danish classes due to serious and prolonged illness, then you can be granted an extension to your "klippe kort" and time period for attending Danish classes, if you have a statement from your doctor. You must be able to provide documentation that you are prevented from participating in Danish classes immediately and no later than the time when you are able to resume your danish education. Please contact your local authority if you wish to apply for an extension the "klippe kort" and education period.
